

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STRONG
BY-LAW #2011-014

BEING a By-law to Stop up, Close and Convey to adjoining Owners
Part of the Original Colonization Road Allowance fronting their property

WHEREAS The Council of the Corporation of the Township of Strong has deemed it expedient and in the interest of the Township of Strong hereinafter called the Township, and that the Original Colonization Road Allowance be stopped up, closed and conveyed to the adjoining land owner(s) and as follows:

1. Part of the Original Colonization Road on a Plan of Survey deposited in the office of Land Titles at Parry Sound as Plan 42R12196, known as Parts 2, 7 and 9 part of the road allowance between lots 10 and 11 through Concession 1, in the Township of Strong

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law was published in the Almaguin News published weekly in the District of Parry Sound on March 17, 2011 & March 31, 2011 as per Road Closing By-law Policies.

AND WHEREAS notice of the proposed by-law was posted up for at least a month in the most public place in the neighbourhood of the said roads;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STRONG DOES HEREBY ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. That upon and after the passing of this By-law all that portion of the Original Colonization Road Allowance as outlined above, in the Township of Strong, District of Parry Sound, be and the same, is hereby stopped up and closed and conveyed to the adjoining Land Owner.

READ A FIRST TIME AND READ A SECOND TIME THIS 12th DAY OF April 2011 AND READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 12th DAY OF April 2011
