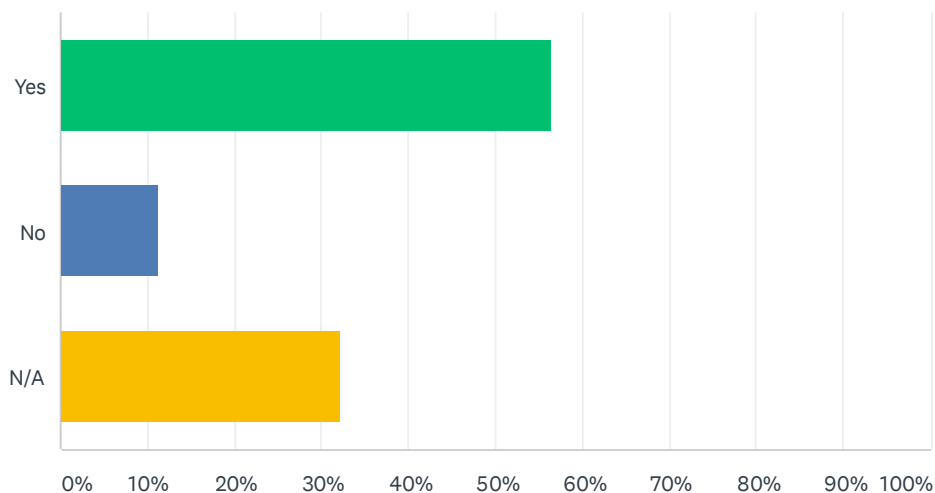

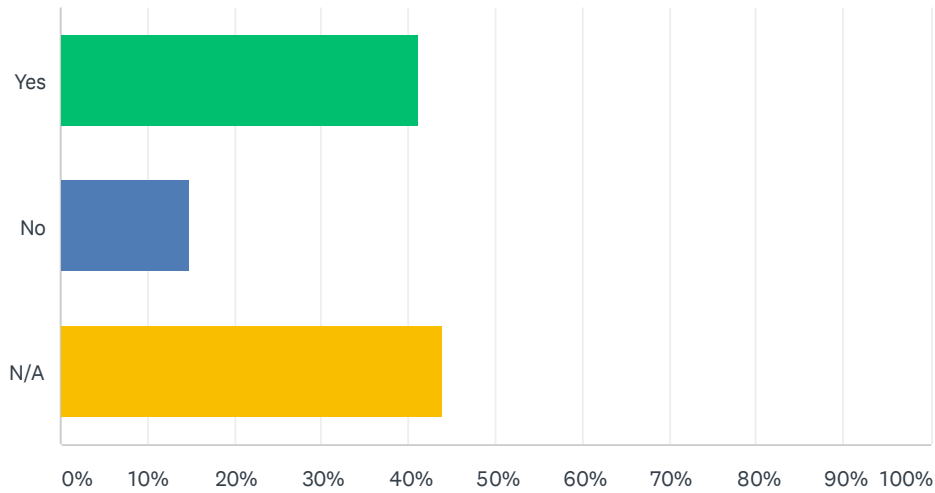

### Q4 Were you able to maintain a consistent schedule to obtain an education for yourself, dependents, or people who you care for between March, 2020 and the present time?

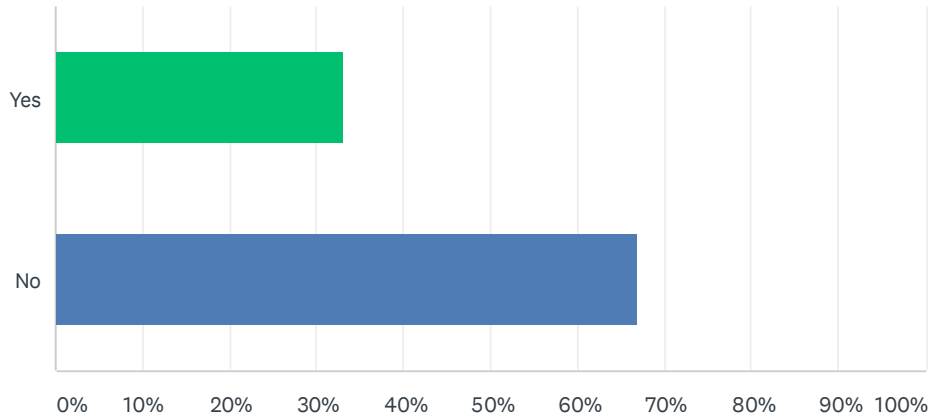

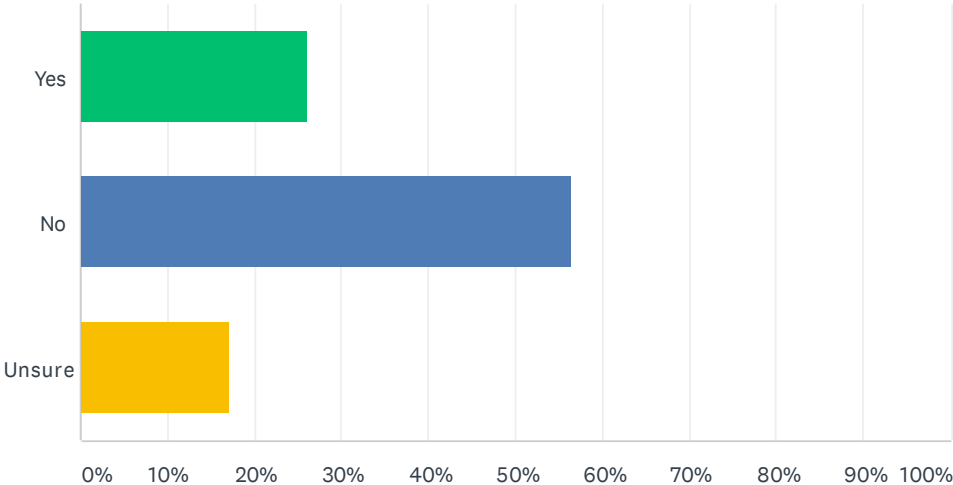

### Q6 Did the pandemic trigger a traumatic response?

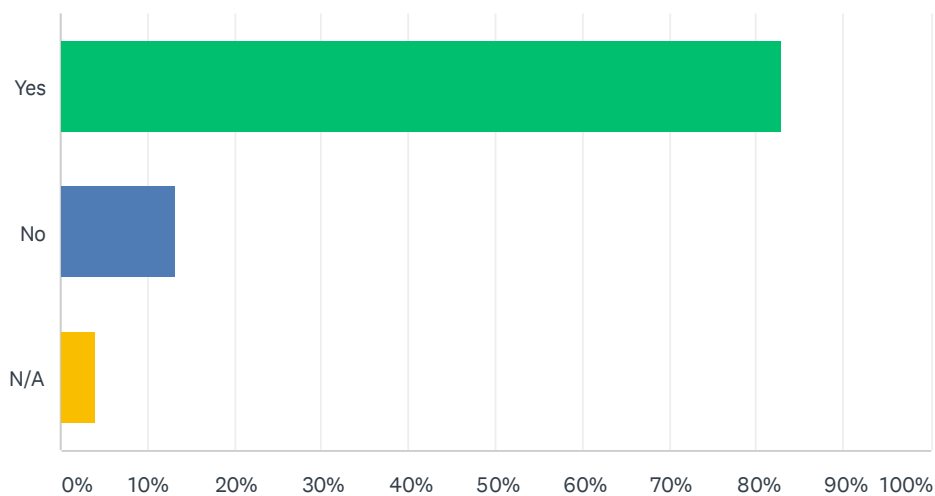

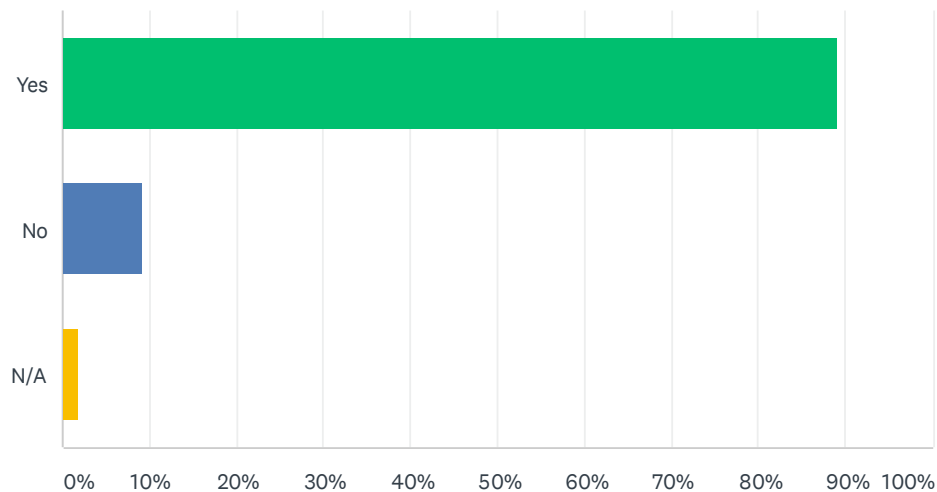

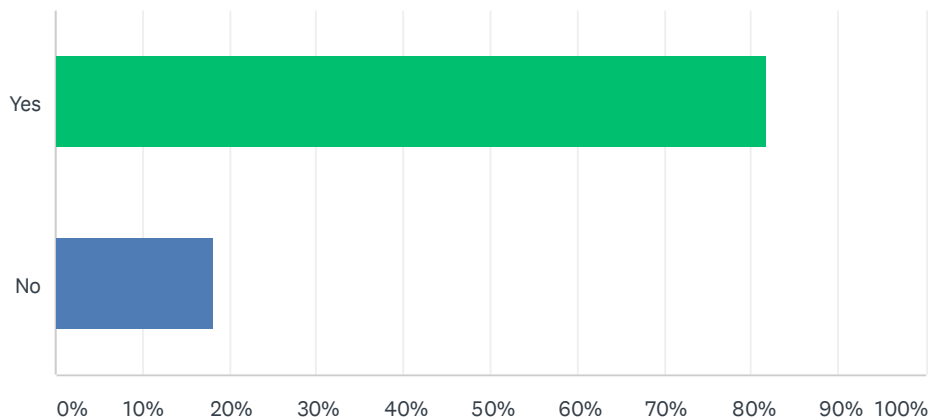

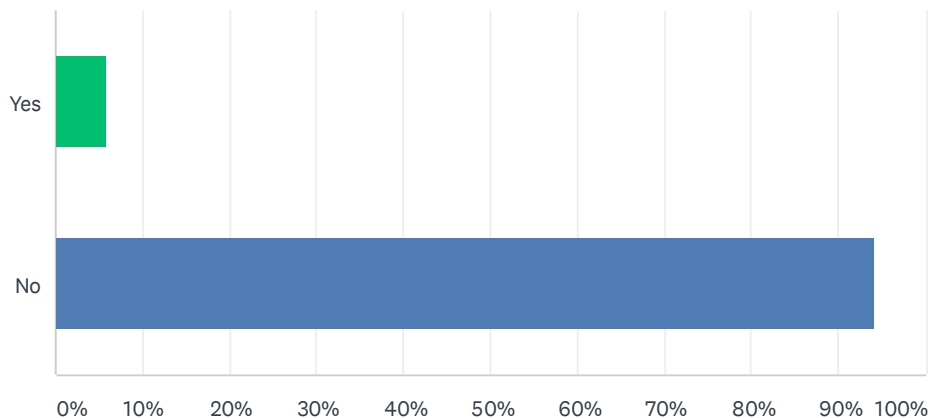

### Q13 Do you have a genetic or physical restriction that requires support to walk, wheel or ride (bike or scooter) to access health services or food?

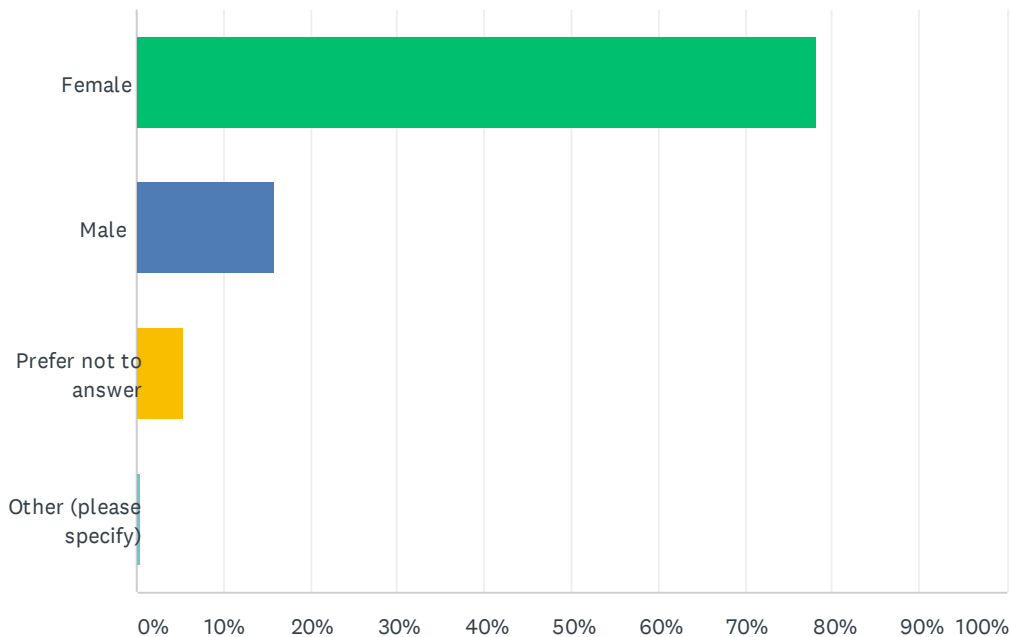

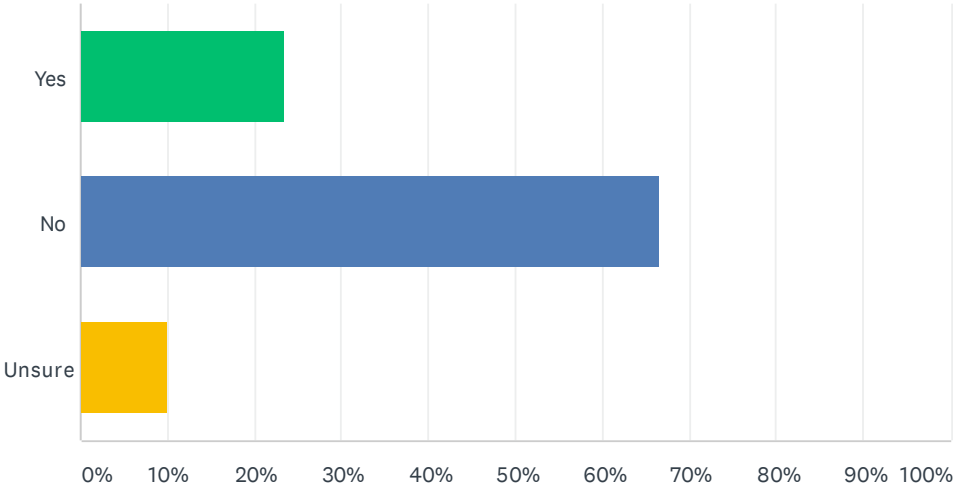

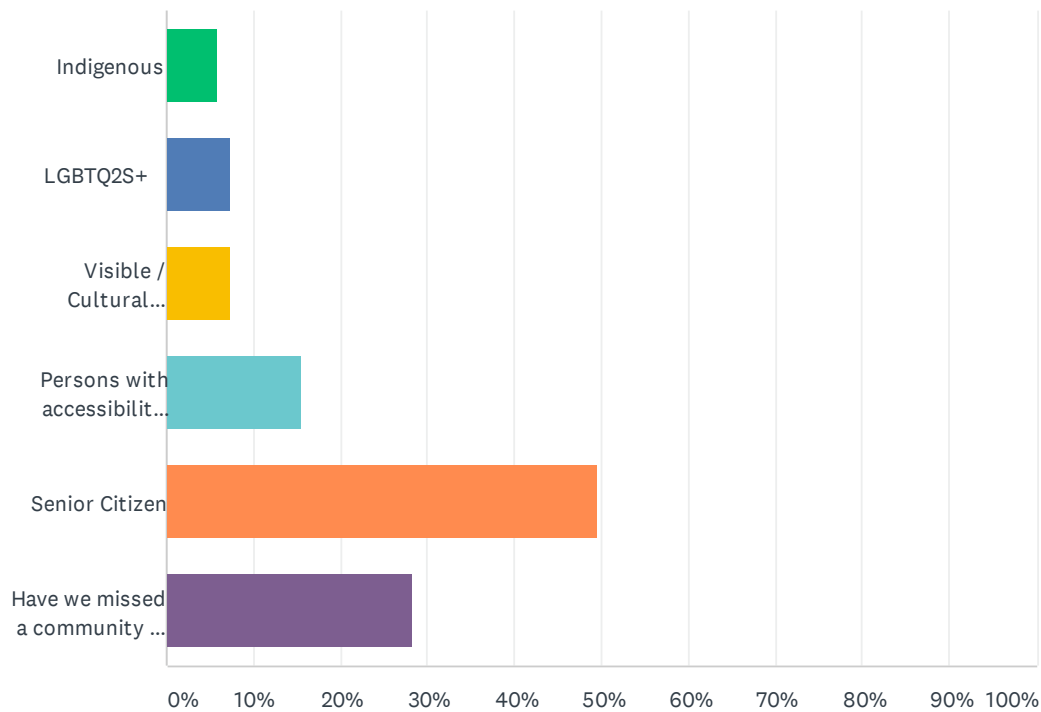

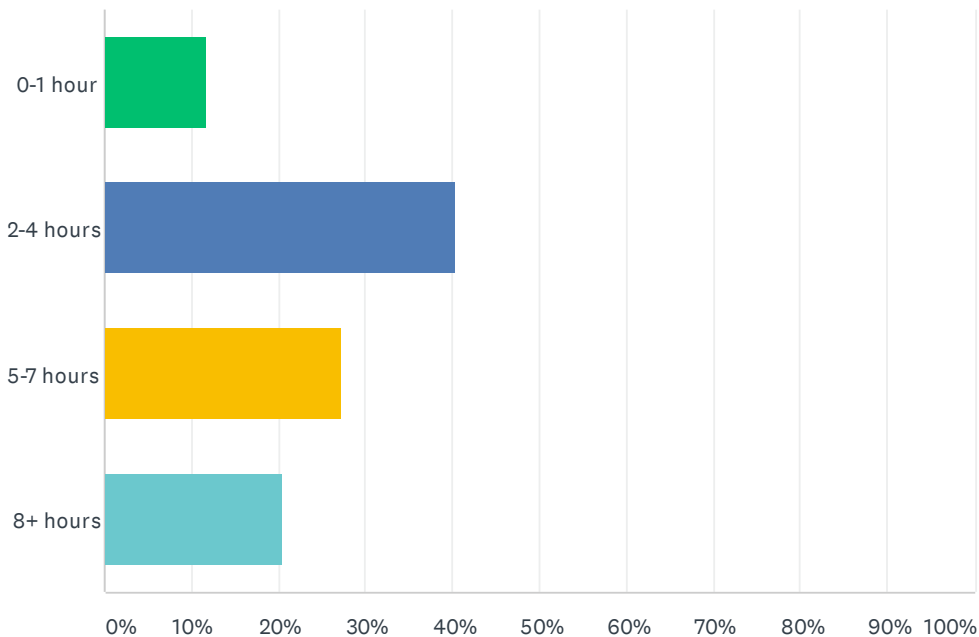
